# HIGHLIGHTS IN ELULS HISTORY

The Environmental Law Committee is created and Wade L. Hopping is appointed the first Chairman.

The Environmental Law Committee becomes the "Environmental Law Section" and the first Section newsletter is published.

The Section name change to the "Environmental and Land Use Law Section" was approved by the Florida Bar Board of Governors in March 1981.

Section membership continues to grow, reaching 1,600 members, and 398 people attended the Annual Update in Amelia Island.

On May 16-17, 1975 the first Federal Environmental Law Seminar is held in Amelia Island.

The Section refocuses with the theme of "Make ELULS Fun Again" and works on connecting with Past Chairs and continuing momentum with Committee restructuring and new members outreach.

The Section celebrates its 25th Anniversary as a Section and launches the Section website ([www.eluls.org](http://www.eluls.org)). The ELULS Treatise is reprinted for the first time.

The ELULS Treatise was made available online in digital format for the first time.

ELULS is a Section in transition. Economic and political changes in the past decade have altered many of members' practices, which has consequently affected the Section. Membership has dropped from a high of over 2,000 to leveling off between 1,500-1,600 members.

ELULS celebrates its 50th anniversary since its inception as the Environmental Law Committee in 1972. The Section brings back the ELULS Update with the 50th Year Update in Amelia Island.
